Background

- **R²D²P is active since 2006**
- **National Reports have been provided at all R²D²P workshops to show progress**
- **The R²D²P is arriving at the end of the “Planning” phase and will embark on “Implementation”**
- **This is a particular stage of the project which deserves a reflection on national achievements and on benefits which resulted from the R²D²P**
- **Reporting on achievements and benefits may help to obtain future financial support**

Work Done

- **The IAEA suggested to report on 11 issues in the field of the legal and regulatory framework, the preparation of decommissioning plans (DP) and the supporting documents for a DP plus anything that was deemed to be important for the national programme**
- **The IAEA suggested to use a standard template for the national reporting**
- **National reports were prepared and distributed amongst the participants before the workshop**

Work to be Done

- **Reports on the national status and on the progress since 2006 should be prepared during the workshop**
- **Basis: National reports distributed before the workshop**
- **Issues and questions should be discussed and clarified during the poster session and personal interactions during the workshop**
- **Two working groups (WG) are suggested to be established to report on:**
 - **WG 1: Status + future improvements**
 - **WG 2: Progress and benefits**
-  **One person per country per WG**

Work to be Done

- **The session on Thursday should be used to prepare the requested reports**
- **Make up your mind before this session on the form [e.g. a written report with a(n) overview chart(s)] and content of the report**
- **Agree on form and content quickly**
- **Identify at an early stage the person to chair the discussion, to prepare the report and to present it**
- **The presentation and discussion of the reports is scheduled for Friday**
- **If necessary, the reports will have to be amended after this discussion**
