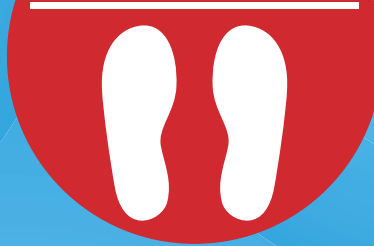
PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES

WASH
YOUR HANDS



With soap and water frequently
for a minimum of 20 seconds

KEEP
DISTANCE



Keep distance between yourself
and others where possible

WEAR
A MASK



As required

If you are feeling ill

- Minimise social contact with others.
- Get rest and stay hydrated.
- Take over-the-counter medication such as paracetamol to help you feel better.
- Stay home and call your doctor or the VIC Medical Service (VMS). Absence type depends on the doctor's assessment.
- Self-report to VMS, if you suspect you have COVID-19, have tested COVID positive.
- Stay at home if you are unwell, develop a fever or have other respiratory symptoms.

Where to get the COVID-19 test in Vienna

- Free rapid antigen tests:
 - Walk-in/drive-through testing centres coronavirus.wien.gv.at/testangebote
 - Pharmacies (free with E-card) apothekerkammer.at
- Alles gurgelt! – free PCR self-tests for you at home: allesgurgelt.at
- Private laboratories (not free of charge)

• Get vaccinated/boosted

- The COVID-19 vaccination and boosters are voluntary and free of charge for all residents in Vienna.
