Join the meeting:

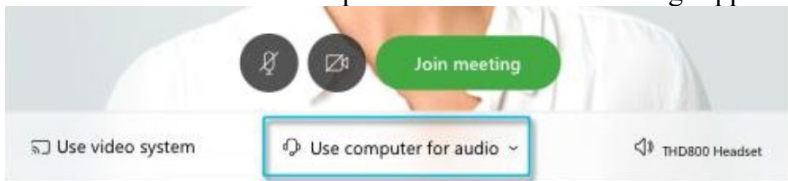

Download the WebEx app on your phone/tablet as a backup solution.

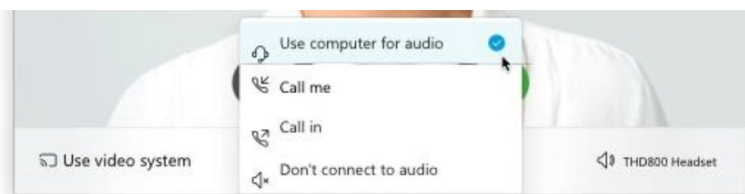
During the meeting

i. Connect Audio:



Click the audio connection options in the Webex Meetings app.



ii. Choose how you want to hear the audio in the meeting (we suggest to “use computer for audio”):





iii. Mute your microphone

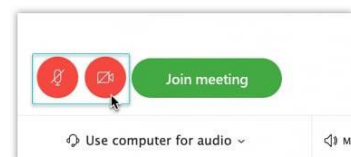
Click Mute my microphone . You'll see  when your microphone is muted.

Click Unmute my microphone  when you want to speak in the meeting.

iv. Start your video

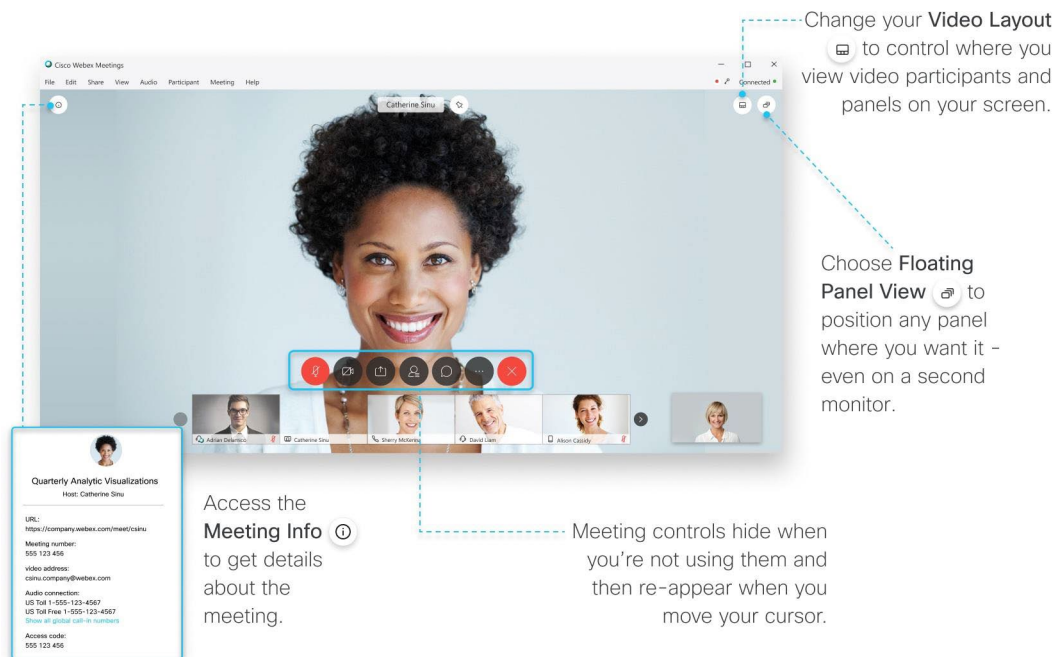
You'll see  when your video is turned off.

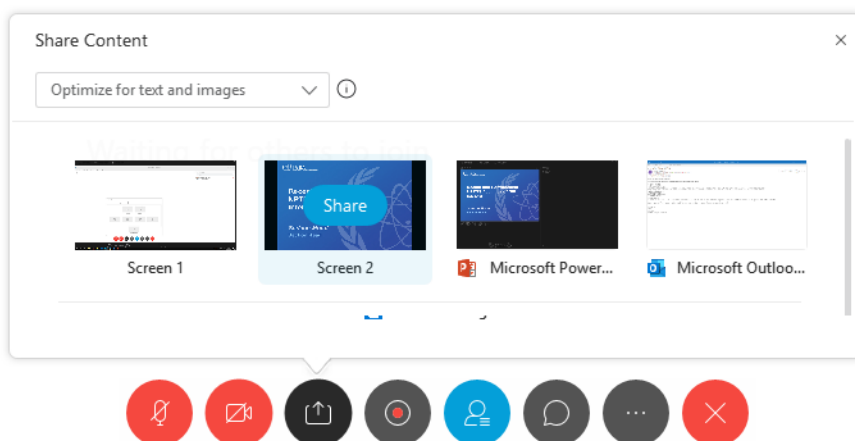
v. During the meeting / configurations

vi. Presenters
