

VIC MEDICAL SERVICE – INFLUENZA VACCINATION CAMPAIGN 2023

VIC Medical Service Influenza Vaccination Campaign will run from 2 to 30 October 2023. The campaign provides staff, particularly those at high risk such as frequent travellers, with the opportunity to protect themselves against influenza.

Increased rates of influenza vaccination during the Covid-19 pandemic, combined with the use of masks and reduced social gatherings and travel, resulted in low levels of influenza cases globally. Now, with more social interaction, there is an increased risk of influenza, particularly during the winter.

The vaccine will be available **free of charge for VIC staff, consultants and interns**. Officially recognised dependants (spouse or children aged 18 - 21 only) can also be vaccinated for a fee of €12.00 which can be paid by bank transfer (account details below).

In addition, the flu vaccination will be available without appointment on 31 October 2023 from 11.00 to 14.00 in the rotunda.

Please note that that you cannot be vaccinated if you:

- have experienced an adverse reaction to a previous flu injection
- have a heavy cold or a fever of 38° C or above
- are pregnant

Please bring the following to your vaccination appointment:

- appointment confirmation (printed or digital)
- signed copy of the consent form (available [here](#))
- yellow vaccination booklet, if available
- proof of payment for each officially recognised dependant
