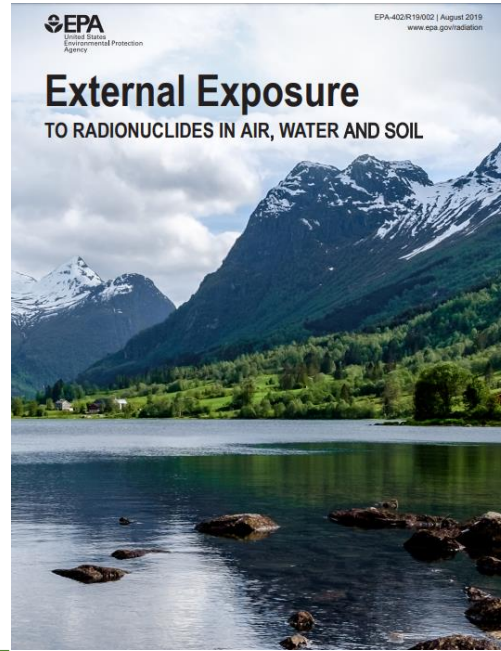
AT THE BEGINNING of the 20th century a group of young women workers who, while licking their brushes to make a fine point, applied radium laden paint to the faces of watches and instruments, began to sicken, and in many cases to die.

Believing that their work was making them ill, the girls turned to their doctors, then to state health and labor departments, but received little help. Finally they turned to the Consumers League, a reform organization founded by Florence Kelley, the socialist organizer who worked with Jane Addams at Hull House, the famous settlement house in

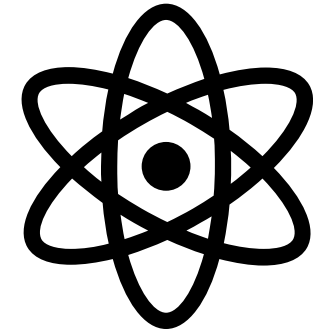

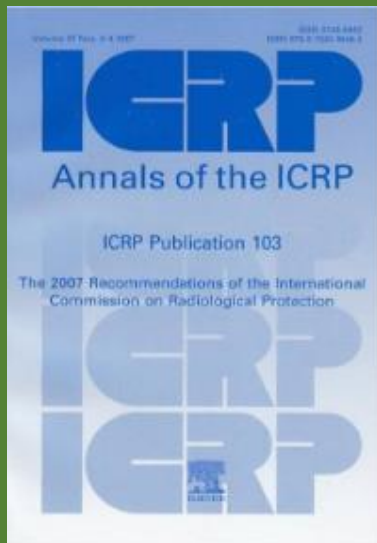

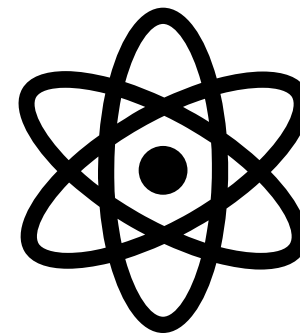

Underground uranium mine and ventilation

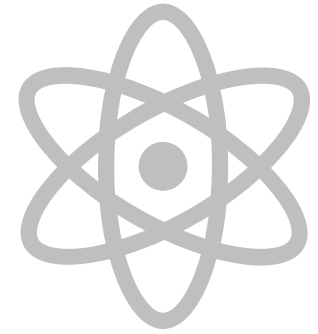

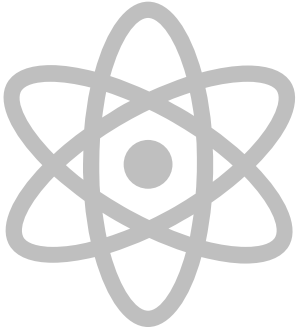

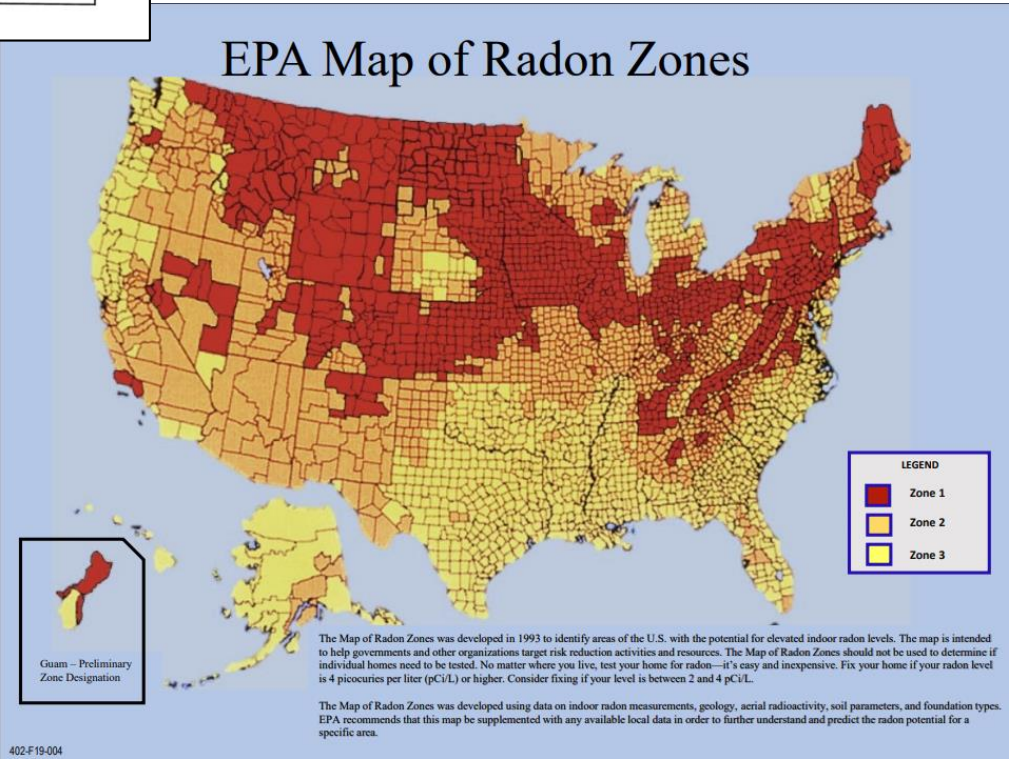
EPA EPA Assessment of Risks from Radon in Homes

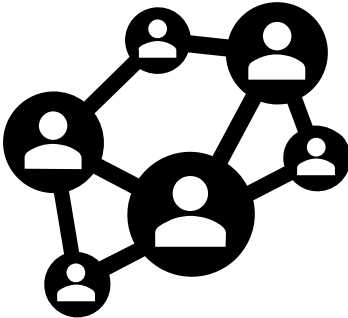

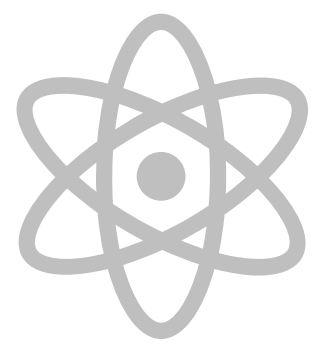

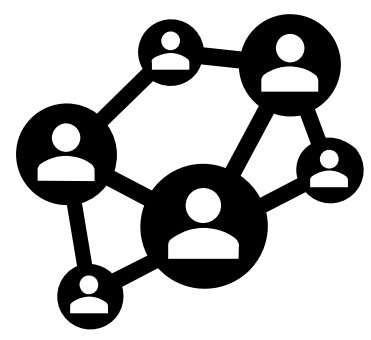

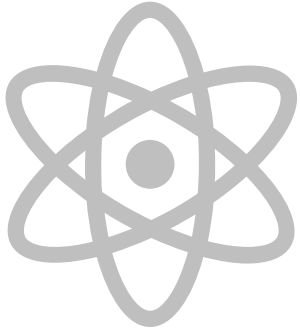
