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The HPGe coaxial detector used has a relative efficiency 40% compared with a standard NaI of 3" \times 3" detector.

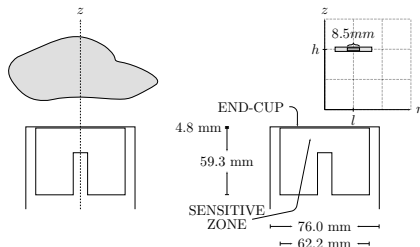


Figure 1: Scheme of the experimental set-up.

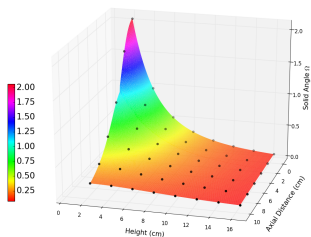


Figure 2: Solid angle values for positions studied in this work.

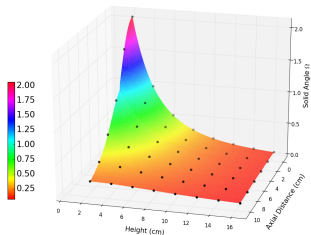


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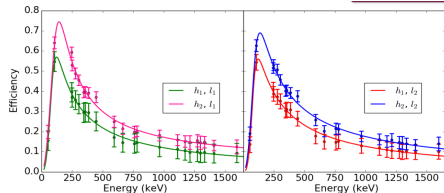


Figure 3: Comparison de intrinsic efficiency for different heights.
